

# DISABLED STUDENT SERVICES

The staff of Disabled Student Services (DSS) assists in the coordination of services needed by adults with the following disabilities:

- Blind or visually impaired
- Deaf or hard of hearing
- Orthopedic
- Learning
- Emotional
- Developmental
- Other disabilities

The Disabled Student Services Department is located in the North Orange County ROP Education Center. For individual vocational plan assessment and course registration, please make an appointment by calling 714- 502-5857.

## SERVICES PROVIDED

### ■ Career Assessment:

Students may receive career interest and basic skills tests to facilitate career exploration as well as selection of an appropriate training program and determination a career goal.

### ■ Vocational Advisement:

Services focus on assistance with course selection that corresponds with the individual's abilities, interests, and goals.

### ■ Community Connections:

Services are provided cooperatively with state and private rehabilitation agencies and a variety of community organizations. Referrals for resources in the community are given, based on the individual's needs.

The Disabled Student Services staff members work with state and private rehabilitation counselors to assist their clients in completing their rehabilitation plans.

### ■ Support Services & Accommodations:

*Accommodations may be provided for individuals with verified disabilities.*

*Those enrolled with a verified disability may qualify for reasonable auxiliary aids or academic accommodations.*

**These services are not retroactive.**

*Students are required to identify themselves as having a disability at time of registration.*

A request for services/accommodations form must be submitted at least **four** (4) weeks prior to the date that the accommodations are needed. The form may be obtained from the Disabled Student Services Department of North Orange County ROP.

- ❖ Other fees for medical and legal clearance may be required.
- ❖ Materials/lab fees are collected at registration. *Make checks payable to North Orange County ROP.*
